Medical Boarding Requirements

Exams:

- **All patients being admitted for medical boarding must have been examined by our doctors within the past 6 months.**
- If they have not, a comprehensive wellness exam will be performed by a doctor upon admission for an additional fee of \$59-76.
- If they have, a brief exam will be performed by a doctor upon admission at no additional charge.
- On a daily basis, medical boarders are examined by our nurses. The fee for this is incorporated into our daily medical boarding charges.

Any vaccine or test required for medical boarding will be performed upon admission at additional charge if proof is not provided.

Cats:

- Proof of current Rabies and Distemper vaccines (\$20-60)
 - If vaccines are not given due to medical conditions, consult a doctor for approval.
- Proof of at least one FELV/FIV test with negative results (\$38.50)
- Fecal exam within 6 months of admission to check for intestinal parasites (\$28.90)

Dogs:

- Proof of current Rabies, Distemper and Bordetella vaccines (\$20-85)
 - If vaccines are not given due to medical conditions, consult a doctor for approval.
- Proof of current Heartworm test (\$70 for 4Dx or \$46 for HWT alone)
- Fecal exam within 6 months of admission to check for intestinal parasites (\$28.90)

Birds:

- Gram Stain within 6 months (\$35.70)

Exotics:

- Fecal within 6 months (\$28.90)
